







children.**




**Wow, I can borrow all these toys!**

must be returned on time or a late fee may be charged.**


**Can children come and play at the toy library?**



**Yes! We love seeing children at the toy library, but members are responsible for supervising their children at the toy library and at all toy library events.**




**What happens if I break or lose one of the  
toys I've borrowed?**




**Toys and their packaging must be cleaned and returned in the state they were borrowed. If either are damaged or lost you must tell us. Wear and tear are expected, but if you cause excessive damage or lose a toy or its packaging you may have to pay for a replacement.**

**How do you keep track of all these toys and people?**





**To make it easy to share news, all members will be part of a membership register that includes email and phone details. The register can be accessed by other members, but will not be shared externally.**

**Members are expected to respond to communications, the toy library works best when we all keep in touch.**





**How can you afford so many toys?**



**We all chip in!**  
**To pay for facilities and toys, members must pay their non-refundable fees when due. If the library is closed for an extended period, members will be compensated.**

**Who does all the work?**




**We depend on volunteer work, so members must choose between being...**

**An INACTIVE MEMBER:** Members do not need to take part in volunteering activities. This costs more.

**Or an ACTIVE MEMBER.** Members participate in volunteering activities such as loans sessions, fundraising, stocktaking and busy bees.



**The library may limit the number of members of either type.**

**What if a member becomes too busy to help out?**



**If members can't volunteer, their membership type may be changed to inactive, and they will be charged the difference. We will talk to them before this happens.**

**Can I borrow any toy I want?**



**Yes! But members should choose toys that are appropriate and safe for their family.**

**Cockburn Toy Library cannot take responsibility for any loss or injury to any party arising from the use of our toys, whether on the premises or elsewhere.**

**Can I borrow toys for my siblings?**

**Yes! Members may borrow toys for other family members, but remain solely responsible for their use and safe return.**


**Can I borrow a ride-on-toy?**

**Yes, but please be careful!**


**If members borrow bicycles or scooters they are solely responsible for the safety of the user.**

**Members must sign the "Waiver, Release and Indemnity for Bicycle and Scooter" form.**


**Members are responsible for ensuring that safety equipment such as helmets and kneepads are used correctly and that the user is supervised at all times.**




Are these all the rules, I need to know?
